Wiley Brown Basketball Clinic

Indiana Southeast University Head Basketball Coach

EQ Wiley Brown enters his 12th season as head coach for the men's basketball program at Indiana University Southeast. During his time at the helm of the program Brown has led the Grenadiers to seven consecutive appearances in the NAIA National Tournament from 2007-08 to 2013-14. Brown has also led his teams to seven consecutive KAC Conference Championships from 2007-08 to 2013-14. The Grenadiers also won six-straight KACTournament titles from 2007-08 to 2012-13. Brown was named the 2010, 2012 and 2014 KAC Men's Basketball Coach of the Year.

A starting forward on the NCAA Division I National Champion basketball team at the University of Louisville in 1980 and a member of the 1982 Final Four team Brown served as strength and conditioning coordinator under both former Louisville Hall of Fame Head Coach Denny Crum and current Louisville Head Coach Rick Pitino for a total of 13 years.

In 2003, Brown served as an interim assistant coach for the Louisville men's basketball program. Beginning in 2005, Brown served Louisville Athletic Director Tom Jurich as the assistant director. Brown is no stranger to playing at a competitive level. As a player at Louisville, Brown posted career totals of 699 points, 407 rebounds and 121 assists, helping the Cardinals to a combined 101-30 four-year record. After his brief stint in the NFL, Brown returned to basketball. For seven years Brown played professional basketball in the International Federation of Basketball where he traveled throughout the world.

More advanced players will work on combination & counter moves to create space and to create separation from the defense.
